



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All players must be a student at their FE College or 6th form and must bring their student ID card to every match.
2. All players must have completed a pre-exercise health questionnaire at their college or 6th form school.
3. All players must report to matches at the time stated and be ready to play at the time of the official start or kick off.
4. It is the responsibility of all players to ensure the changing rooms, both home and away, is left in a pristine condition and all rubbish put in bins provided.
5. All valuables are the responsibility of the individual player. The KCSSA or college / 6th form will not be responsible for any personal belongings or valuable items lost.
6. All players must ensure that their college coursework is kept up to date. Course Tutors may withdraw a player from a squad if the player has outstanding assignments / disciplinary issues.
7. All players must attend fixtures as required unless reported sick or injured.
8. All injuries or illnesses must be reported to the team manager as soon as possible. Injuries sustained during a match must be reported on an accident form particularly those requiring first aid or a visit to hospital.
9. All players must respect the staff and rules and regulations of their College or 6th form and observe all instructions of the team manager both on and off the pitch.
10. All players must respect the coaching staff, officials, each other, the opposition and the facilities hosting the event or competition.
11. All players must respect the decisions of the officials and their assistants.
12. Fines for bookings and sending offs are the responsibility of the individual player not the college or 6th form.
13. Failure to deal with the fines individually will result in a ban from the college team. Disciplinary action could ultimately lead to the college with-holding their qualification.
14. Any breach of the above codes may result in a player being banned and where appropriate the banning of the whole team for a duration of 1 to 3 games. Final decisions will be made by the Officials and / or KCSSA Executive.
15. For football, any further disciplinary action brought by the KCSSA would be in addition to KCFA disciplinary action. The disciplinary procedures of all other sports governing bodies will be upheld and enforced.
