



Season 2019/20 – Football Grand Prix 6 A-Side Tournaments

Men's 6 A-Side Football

Please remember that none of the following points will be tolerated.

- 1) Foul or abusive language.
- 2) Deliberate rough or dangerous play.
- 3) Confrontation in any way with any opposing team / player / official.

If any of these incidents occur, the referee will take the following action:

- i) Suspend a player for a specified period of time.(sin bin)
- ii) Warn a player, resulting in a yellow card
- iii) Any player receiving a second yellow card **in any match** will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- iv) Issue a red card and send a player off, who will no longer be allowed to participate in the rest of the tournament. (no substitute will be allowed to play for the player sent off)

Please note that any bad behaviour or other forms of misconduct that may occur off the pitch, that is considered inappropriate in any way or form, will be taken very seriously and may result in your whole team being disqualified from the tournament.

- 1) All matches will be supervised by appointed NGB FA qualified officials.
- 2) All participants must be registered as students with their college or academy or as part of a local sports partnership.
(In the event of any disputes, a College ID card may be requested to clarify proof of their enrolment as a student). **No members of staff or Coaches may play for the team.**
- 3) Three (3) points will be awarded for a win and one (1) point for a draw.
- 4) If, at the completion of group matches, points are equal, the following rules will apply to determine final positions:

- Goal Difference
- Most Goals scored
- Fewest Goals conceded
- The result of the match between both teams
- Penalty Shoot Out

- 5) Failure to appear on the pitch at the appropriate start time, the team will forfeit team points and a score of 2-0 will be recorded.
- 6) No student can play for more than 1 team in each competition
- 7) If a player is sent off in any match he will be suspended for the rest of the tournament. The referee decision will be final.
- 8) In the event of a colour clash, the second named team will either change team strip or wear bibs. Bibs must be provided by each team.
- 9) The decision of the individual referees and tournament organisers are Final
- 10) All players must wear shin-pads when playing in the tournament. (No exception)
- 11) Players must not wear aluminium or metal tipped studs. (Astro pitch footwear only).

MALE 6 A-SIDE FOOTBALL

RULES & REGULATIONS

All Teams must be affiliated to the Kent FA and participants must be aged 16yrs - under 25yrs (on 31st August) and registered as a student with their FE College or Learning Academy.

All Teams will be required to provide two suitable match balls to ensure continuous play and a set of bibs for colour clashes.
Team colours will be decided by both teams prior to the match / competition.

Teams must be registered and ready to play at least 10 minutes before the kick off of each match.

It is a condition of entry that all players adhere to the KCSSA code of conduct and that none of the following points will be tolerated.

- 1) Foul or abusive language (Including racial abuse).
- 2) Deliberate rough or dangerous play.
- 3) Confrontation in any way with any opposing team / player / official.

If any of the above incidents occur, the referee will take the following action:

- i) Suspend a player for a specified period of time.(sin bin)
- ii) Warn a player, resulting in a yellow card
- iii) Issue a red card and send a player off, who will no longer be allowed to participate in the rest of the match.
(No substitute will be allowed to play for the player sent off)

Players, team managers / coaches and spectators shall behave in a manner that does not result in any bad behaviour both on and off the pitch.
Incidents of physical or verbal abuse will be taken seriously and may result in the whole team being disqualified from the competition.

Each college entering the competition will be responsible for their own spectator's behaviour and conduct throughout the event.

Rules of play

- 1) The match will be 12 minutes one way. (3 minutes for change over).
- 2) The matches will be supervised by independent FA Qualified Referee organised by the KCSSA.
- 3) There will be 4 substitutes allowed per team on a 'Roll on Roll off' basis.

If you have any further questions or want to clarify the rules then please ask the Referee / Officials on the day before the start of the competition.

NOTE; Match timings may be amended prior to each competition dependant on the entries on the day.

The Referee and Officials decision is final in all disputes.
